

Privacy Statement Two Day Military Achievement Tour (TMPT)

What is the TMPT?

The TMPT is a tour in which the participants demonstrate a wide range of military skills and stamina. The TMPT is organized by the TMPT committee of the Royal Association of Dutch Reserve Officers, established in Stroe, Wolweg 100, 3776 LR (hereafter referred to as: KVNRO). The TMPT Committee works closely with the LO/Sport Organization of the Royal Netherlands Army. KVNRO is responsible for the processing of personal data, as described in this privacy statement. As a participant in the TMPT, you share personal data with the TMPT Committee. This privacy statement applies to TMPT participants. We believe it is important that your personal data is handled with care. This privacy statement explains what personal data are processed by KVNRO, for what purpose and in what way this is done. It also explains what rights the parties involved have and how they can be exercised. What is personal data?

Personal data is defined as all information about an identified or identifiable natural person, such as contact details, bank account number and date of birth. Special personal data include, for example, data about racial or ethnic origin, criminal history, religious or philosophical beliefs, trade union membership, data about health or sexual behavior.

What personal data does KVNRO process and for what purpose?

When registering to participate in the TMPT, we ask for a number of personal details. These data are necessary to participate in the TMPT and we process them in our database. During the TMPT, (action) photos and videos are taken for promotional purposes of the TMPT and/or the KVNRO, on which you may be seen. If you object to this, please let the TMPT committee know. Participation in the TMPT is not possible without providing your personal details. In addition, KVNRO is legally obliged to process certain personal data. TMPT does not process any special personal data. The table below shows the purpose for which we collect which personal data from you and how long we keep them.

When does KVNRO share personal data?

Registration for the TMPT takes place via the website of the TMPT (www.kvnro.nl/tmpt). This site is hosted by Faceworks BV. Faceworks collects all registrations up to 2 weeks before the start of the TMPT and then converts them into a database which they transfer to the treasurer of the TMPT committee. After this, Faceworks deletes all data in its possession. The only file containing personal data is then in the possession of the treasurer of the TMPT committee. The latter shares this file with the chairman and the secretariat of the TMPT committee. Without your permission, the KVNRO will only provide your personal data to third parties if this is necessary due to a legal obligation.

How are personal data protected?

KVNRO takes appropriate measures to protect your personal data against loss, unauthorized access, publication and unlawful processing. The personal data is transmitted via a secure Internet connection (TLS), identified by "https" and the padlock symbol in the browser's address bar. Furthermore, KVNRO has guaranteed in its systems that not everyone within its organization has access to personal data. Access is limited to persons for whom the processing of personal data is necessary for the performance of their work.

Links to other websites

The TMPT website may contain links to other websites. This Privacy Statement applies only to the TMPT website pages. Other websites may have their own privacy policies. The TMPT recommends that you always consult the relevant privacy statements of other websites before using them.

What rights do participants have?

KVNRO respects the rights of participants with regard to their personal data. Some rights can always be exercised; others only under certain conditions. Participants can exercise the following rights:

- Withdrawal of consent given for processing of personal data;

- Access to personal data;
- Correction of incorrect personal data;
- Deletion of personal data if they are no longer necessary;
- Objecting to the processing of personal data;
- Limitation of the processing of personal data in cases determined by law;
- Data transfer of own personal data provided to the KVNRO in cases determined by law;
- Submit a complaint about the processing of personal data by the KVNRO to the Authority for Personal Data.

These rights can only be exercised with regard to the personal data held by the KVNRO. KVNRO may ask participants to identify themselves in more detail.

Changes to the privacy policy

The TMPT updates its privacy statement from time to time to keep it up to date. The TMPT website will always include the most recent version of our Privacy Statement. The TMPT therefore recommends that you consult the Privacy Statement regularly.
